

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: - REQUIREMENTS:

- Skaters may enter those official events in which they are eligible to compete in at the 2015-16 Regional Championships.
- Primary, Juvenile, Elementary, Freshman and Sophomore division skaters may also **Challenge UP one division.**
- Crossovers will be allowed between Classic, Novice, Esquire, Masters, Veterans, and Golden divisions as age permits.
- Senior and Junior World Class Solo and Team Dance will skate their compulsory dances. Free Dance will be optional. Senior and Junior World Class Singles and Pairs events will skate both their short and long programs.
- When an event becomes a final without elimination, the elimination requirements will be skated. All Team and Solo Dance Events with 10 or less skaters registered will be skated as a **final event.**
- Skating times for all singles, pairs, free dance and solo creative dance events will be observed in accordance with USA Roller Skating 2015-2016 published requirements.
- **All skaters must have a valid 2015 amateur card on file at the National Office.**
- Anyone interested in judging or acting as referee or figure steward, please contact Anthony DaPonte or Dorothy DeRemer with the days and times you would be available (please put "judging", "referee", or "steward" in the subject line).
- **Newcomer Program – We will be following the Newcomer program that was used at the NE Regional's. Application and Waiver forms will be available in the packet. Please submit your application and SIGNED waiver form in the packet. Entree fee's will be \$10.00 per event.**
